

Installation Instructions

Required Tools

To install your PeaceWheel you will need:

- a medium slotted screwdriver
- a pair of pliers
- a 5/16 nut wrench, (the one with the yellow handle)

Installation

1. First **remove the front grill:**
 - Turn the five screws at the top of the grill a half of turn to loosen. Make sure that you hold on to the grill so that it does not fall on to the ground.
 - When all five screws are loosened, gently rock the grill back from the van and lift it up and out of the lower slots of the grill mount.
2. Set the grill on something soft like a blanket or rug and **remove the old VW emblem:**
 - The VW emblem can be removed by twisting off the plastic studs with a vice grip or pliers. Unfortunately this will render the emblem useless for further remounting. If you can figure a way to remove the old emblem with out damaging it good luck.
3. With the old emblem now removed you can now **install the new PeaceWheel:**
 - Lay the new PeaceWheel on a soft firm surface like a rug and set the grill over the top of it. Make sure the pins align with the holes on the grill as you do this.
 - Carefully install the push nuts on to the PeaceWheel studs by pushing them onto the studs with a 5/16 nut wrench. Make sure that the push nut is turned to the right side for installation.
4. After the PeaceWheel is mounted, **reinstall the grill:**
 - Align the lower slots of the grill in there respective holes. Make sure that they are all in their holes or the top screws will not align correctly and the grill will fall off.
 - Tighten the top screws a half turn. Check to make sure that the screws are seated. You will hear and feel the screw do so as this happens.
 - Tug on the grill before you let go to make sure that it is correctly install and will not fall off.
